## Rules of order in Kitee Evangelical Folk High School

The purpose of the rules is to guarantee safety, peace of mind and comfort for every student and staff member of the college. To be successful, coexistence always requires jointly accepted rules, which are valid throughout the area of Kitee Evangelical Folk High School.

To increase security, there is also camera surveillance in the college area. The order rules are as follows:

1. The student is responsible for the comfort and study peace of the study facilities and dormitory. Using mental and/or physical violence is prohibited.

- 2. The dormitory is closed during school holidays. Staying in the dormitory during lessons without a valid reason is considered truancy. To ensure pleasant living, residents clean their rooms once a week. As a rule, adults can also live in the dormitory on weekends.
- 3. Dormitory doors are kept locked. The code/key must not be given to another person. Minors must arrive at the dormitory at 9:00 p.m. Silence in the dormitory starts at 10:00 p.m. €50 is charged for opening the doors between 21:00 and 07:00.
- 4. Those living in the dormitory can receive guests in the leisure area from Monday to Thursday from 17:00 to 21:00. Visits at other times are agreed upon with the dormitory counselor/student guardian. Mon Fri from 09:00 17:00 visitors are not allowed to stay in the college area. Each student is responsible for their guests.
- 5. Smoking (including e-cigarettes) is not allowed on campus except in designated smoking areas
- 6. Consuming alcohol and other intoxicants on the campus, being under the influence of intoxicants and bringing intoxicants into the area is prohibited. The sale of tobacco, alcohol or other intoxicating substances on the premises of the college is prohibited. The rule also applies to study trips and excursions. Violation of the rule results in immediate expulsion from the dormitory/studies for a specified period of time or in its entirety.
- 7. The staff must be notified immediately about the damage to the college's property and intentional vandalism. Compensation for the damage will be agreed with the student services manager.
- 8. Cars and other vehicles are parked in the college's lower parking lot.
- 9. The use of the mobile phones is allowed during the lesson only with the permission of the teacher. Phones are left at the beginning of the lesson in the place reserved for phones (phone park).
- 10. If a student has to be absent from teaching or an arranged meeting due to illness or another reason, the teacher or line manager of the class in question must be notified in advance. Leave of absence for one or more days is requested from the teacher in charge. Compensation for absences is agreed upon with the teacher of each subject. Those who live at the college must always notify the community counselor of absences at night.
- 11. Violation of order rules, unauthorized absences, fraudulent activity, such as cheating/cribbing, or gambling and/or inappropriate behavior will result in disciplinary measures: speaking, written warning, temporary or complete expulsion from the dormitory/training. Violations of the order rules are always reported to the parents/guardians of underage students.
